There will be an in-depth study of graphing, polynomials, quadratic equations, data analysis, and system of equations through direct class instruction, group work, homework, student projects, and technology.


REQUIRED MATERIALS:

COURSE BREAKDOWN:

- 10% **Notebook:** Each notebook check is worth 20 points and there will be 3 notebook checks per semester.

- 10% **Homework/Projects**: Each homework assignment is worth 5 point, projects are worth 20 points.
