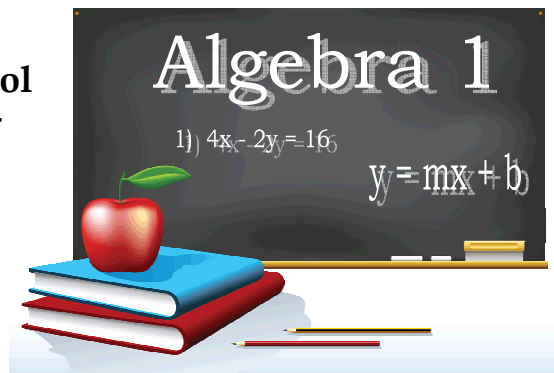

DESCRIPTION OF COURSE:

Algebra 1 is intended to build a foundation for all higher math classes. This course will review algebraic expressions, integers, and mathematical properties that will lead into working with variables and linear equations. There will be an in-depth study of graphing, polynomials, quadratic equations, data analysis, and system of equations through direct class instruction, group work, homework, student projects, and technology.

REQUIRED MATERIALS:

COURSE BREAKDOWN:

10% - **Notebook:** Each notebook check is worth 20 points and there will be 3 notebook checks per semester.

30% - **Classwork/Exit Tickets:** Each is worth 5 points.

10% - **Homework/Projects:** Each homework assignment is worth 5 point, projects are worth 20 points.

50% - **Assessments (Quiz/Test):** Quiz is worth 20 points, Test is worth 100 points, and Final is worth 200 points.

Attached is a rubric for your notebook check. Keep the rubric in your binder for each notebook check. In order to get full credit on your notebook you must turn in a binder with all the work you have completed in the semester as well as the spiral notebook.
